

892.1 Driving Improvement Program

If you have a CDL or have had a moving violation in the last 2 years prior to your current ticket, you may come and speak to the District Attorney on your scheduled court date as you do not qualify for our Driving Improvement Program.

To check if you have had a moving violation in the last 2 years, contact your local Department of Motor Vehicles to obtain your driving record.

If you do not have a CDL and have not had any prior moving violations in the last 2 years, you qualify for a court approved Driving Improvement Program. Court approved programs will be listed immediately following this message.

Complete the court approved Defensive Driving class and print the certificate of completion. You may mail in the certificate and a money order or cashier's check to pay your fine. Money orders and cashier's checks must be made Payable to the East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Office and must be for the exact amount of the ticket. The certificate and payment can be mailed care of the 19th Judicial District Court Traffic Office to PO Box 3202, Baton Rouge, LA, 70821. Please be advised that it may take up to 3 weeks for your payment to be processed.

If you would like to submit your certificate and payment in person, you may do so within 2 weeks prior to your original court date. Please bring the certificate of completion and payment to the Traffic Office located at 300 North Blvd, BR, LA, 70802 Room 2601 on the 2nd Floor. Accepted forms of payment are cash, money order, or a Visa/Mastercard. We do not accept personal checks.

Instructions: Please return to the Traffic Office, Room 2601 (2nd Floor) with your certificate of completion and payment to receive your dismissal. After reporting to the Traffic Office, staff will provide you with the required payment form to bring to the Sheriff's Fines Desk, also located on the 2nd Floor. The fines desk accepts cash, cashier's check, money orders, and Visa/MasterCard (3% credit/debit processing fee) to conclude your case. No personal checks or payroll checks.
